**SHOW RULES**



Failure To Follow Show Rules Could Result in Disqualification!

1. Participants must be a 2005 4-H member to show, as stated in the Official Handbook of the Indiana 4-H Horse and Pony program. All classes will follow the rules set forth in the current Indiana 4-H Horse & Pony Handbook. 4-H members are encouraged to obtain 4-H handbooks from their County Extension Office.
2. All 4-H members are required to wear a properly fitted ASTM or SEI standard F116 (or above) certified equestrian helmet whenever mounted, or driving, at a 4-H Horse and Pony event, show or activity. The 4-H member is responsible to see that this specified headgear is properly fitted with the approved harness fastened in place whenever mounted. Original tags must be present in all approved helmets. This policy will be in effect beginning with the 2003 program year and applies to all county, area, and state 4-H Horse and Pony events, shows, and activities.
3. Must have a copy of your 2005 Indiana 4-H Horse & Pony Enrollment Form (4-H 516) in hand at the entry booth.
4. We reserve the right to measure any pony in the show.
5. All 4-H riders in the 4-H show must wear the proper footwear of western, hunt, or jodhpur boots. Drivers must wear boots or closed shoes.
6. Absolutely no non-4-H riders allowed, including younger siblings! Rider and horse will be exited from the grounds, if this rule is broken.
7. LaGrange County 4-H H&P Club, LaGrange County Fair Association, and Area XI 4-H Horse & Pony Committee are not responsible for accidents or loss of property.
8. Class winners qualify for the Indiana State Fair.
9. All 1<sup>st</sup> place class winners must have their photo taken by a show official with their animal immediately following winning class. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.
10. An animal may be shown by one exhibitor at the area show (one horse, one rider).
11. Up to two 4-H animals may be shown, but only one animal entered per class.
12. Mare and foal class will be split in to horse or pony, with a minimum of 3 entries per class.
13. Decisions regarding the area show (except for judge's decision) will be finalized by the Area XI Horse & Pony Committee.
14. Judge's decision is final. No money will be refunded.
15. \*\*Trail classes will be judged at an alternate location on show/fairgrounds. Members have the opportunity to compete in the Trail class at their convenience between 4 and 7 p.m.
16. GRIEVANCE PROCEDURE: All grievances filed must follow the State Fair grievance policy. A grievance at the area show must be presented in writing and notarized on the official State Fair Grievance Form and filed with the Area XI Horse & Pony Committee within 1 hour of the results of the class placing.
17. Grade is considered as of January 1, current year.
18. Area Committee has right to cancel, combine or split classes.
19. All animals must remain on the LaGrange County 4-H Fairgrounds at all times.
20. All classes: the contestant has 60 seconds to enter the arena.
21. Parents cannot approach the judge, if there is a question or problem it should be brought to the attention of the ring steward.
